

EXTRACTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF

IN THE VILLAGE HALL IN SAID VILLAGE OF CALUMET, ON
THE 9 DAY OF February 1965, at 7 o'clock P.M.

On the 9 day of February 1965, the Council of the

ORDINANCE NO. 92

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A HOUSING COMMISSION FOR THE
VILLAGE OF CALUMET

WHEREAS, there is a shortage of safe and sanitary dwelling
accommodations in the said Village of Calumet, available to persons
who lack the amount of income which is necessary to enable them,
without financial assistance, to live in decent, safe and sanitary
dwellings without over-crowding; and

WHEREAS, it is for the public interest that a housing commission
be created in the said Village of Calumet;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Village of Calumet ordains:

Section 1. Pursuant to Public Act No. 18 of the Extra Session
of 1933, as amended, a commission is hereby created in and for the

Village of Calumet, Michigan, to be known as the "Calumet Housing Commission".

Section 2. The President of the said Village of Calumet is hereby directed to appoint the members of the said Calumet Housing Commission as soon as possible after this Ordinance shall take effect.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to cause this Ordinance to be published as soon as possible in the Daily Mining Gazette, a newspaper of general circulation in the County of Houghton and Village of Calumet, Michigan, and to be posted in three public places in the Village of Calumet.

The motion to adopt said Ordinance was seconded by

Yea: Messrs: Drier, Wickstrom, Asselin, LaBonte, Boudin & Baroni


