Caleb Katz, Village Administrator, reported that MEDC had agreed to provide funding for preparing new DDA and TIF plans and a new Zoning Ordinance.

There was a lengthy discussion as to whether an adult use marihuana business would require a "special use" permit as provided by the Village's Zoning Ordinance. The consensus was that no "special use" permit is necessary, rather such businesses would fall under permitted uses as defined by the current Zoning Ordinance such as "pharmacy."
