2. Resolution - Opting Out Adult Use Marihuana

The following resolution was offered by _____, and seconded by _____.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, MCL § 333.27951 et seq. (the "Act"), the Village is permitted to limit or prohibit Marihuana Establishments, as that term is defined in the Act, within its boundaries.

WHEREAS, the Village Council adopted Ordinance No. 153, entitled Village of Calumet Adult-Use Marihuana Facilities Ordinance, permitting certain Marihuana Establishments within the Village boundaries on _____.

WHEREAS, the Adult-Use Marihuana Facilities Ordinance is not effective until _____.

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan will accept Marihuana Establishment applications on November 1, 2019.

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to completely prohibit all Marihuana Establishments within its boundaries until the Village of Calumet Adult-Use Marihuana Facilities Ordinance (as enacted or as amended if amended prior to December 14, 2019) becomes effective, including, but not limited to, any marihuana retailer, marihuana safety compliance facility, marihuana processor, marihuana microbusiness, marihuana secure transporter, or any other type of marihuana-related business, as licensed by the State of Michigan under the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Village of Calumet hereby prohibits all Marihuana Establishments within the boundaries of the Village pursuant to the Act, as may be amended, until the Village of Calumet Adult-Use Marihuana Facilities Ordinance (as enacted or as amended if amended prior to the effective date December 14, 2019) becomes effective, at which point, the Village of Calumet Adult-Use Marihuana Facilities Ordinance shall govern Marihuana Establishments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution shall become effective upon passage.
