

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE THROWSING OF SNOW FROM ANY BUILDING UPON THE STREETS, SIDEWALKS, AND/OR ALLEYS OF THE VILLAGE OF CALUMET AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE VILLAGE OF CALUMET ORDAINS:

Section One. It shall be unlawful and punishable as provided in Section Two of this ordinance for any person, copartnership, corporation or association to throw or cause to be thrown any snow and/or ice upon the streets, sidewalks, and/or alleys of the Village of Calumet so as to interfere with traffic upon and over said streets, sidewalks, and/or alleys or so as to interfere with the full work and operations of the fire department in the event of a fire, without first conferring with the Village officials and arranging for the removal of such snow and/or ice and the protection of pedestrians using such streets, sidewalks and/or alleys.

Section Two. Any persons violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be punished with a fine not exceeding Ten (\$10.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the County Jail not exceeding ten (10) days or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court, with costs of prosecution to be added in each case.
