

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE
PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES UPON THE STREETS OF THE
VILLAGE OF CALUMET AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS THEREOF.

THE VILLAGE OF CALUMET ORDAINS:

Section One. It shall be unlawful and punishable as provided (in Section Four) of this ordinance for any person, partnership, corporation or association to park or cause to be parked any motor vehicle, trailer, logging trailer and/or horse drawn sleigh upon the streets and/or sidewalks of the Village of Calumet:

- 1a. In areas designated as R zones between the hours of 12 midnight and 8 a.m.
- 1b. In areas designated as B zones between the hours of 2 a.m. and 8 a.m.
- 1c. In areas designated as C zones between the hours of 9 p.m. and 8 a.m.

Section Two. "Motor vehicle" as used in this ordinance shall include all vehicles defined as motor vehicles under the Michigan Motor Vehicle Law.

Section Three. "Parking", for the purpose of this ordinance, is hereby defined to mean the standing of any motor vehicle, trailer, logging trailer and/or horse drawn sleigh upon a street and/or sidewalk in the Village, whether in charge of a driver or without such driver, for a longer period than is necessary to actually load or unload or to take or let off passengers.

Section Four. Any persons violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be punished with a fine not exceeding Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the County Jail not exceeding ten (10) days or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court, with costs of prosecution to be added in each case.
