

AN ORDINANCE TO DEFINE AND REGULATE THE
OPERATION AND USE OF TRAILER COACHES. #88

THE VILLAGE OF CALUMET ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE, A TRAILER COACH
IS HEREBY DEFINED AND DECLARED TO BE ANY VEHICLE USED OR SO
CONSTRUCTED AS TO PERMIT ITS BEING USED AS A CONVEYANCE UPON
THE PUBLIC STREETS AND WHICH INCLUDES SELF-PROPELLED AND
NON SELF-PROPELLED VEHICLES, SO DESIGNED, CONSTRUCTED, RE-
CONSTRUCTED OR ADDED TO BY MEANS OF AN ENCLOSED ADDITION OR
ROOM IN SUCH A MANNER AS WILL PERMIT THE OCCUPANCY THEREOF
AS A DWELLING OR SLEEPING PLACE FOR ONE OR MORE PERSONS, AND
HAVING AS A FOUNDATION WHEELS, JACKS OR SKIRTINGS.

SECTION 2.

NO PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION SHALL USE OR PERMIT
THE USE OF ANY TRAILER COACH AS A RESIDENCE ON ANY SITE, LOT,
FIELD OR TRACT OF LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF
CALUMET, EXCEPT IN THAT PART OF THE VILLAGE BETWEEN (OAK
STREET AND PINE STREET, WEST OF MAPLE LANE, AND SUCH TRAILER
WILL COMPLY WITH ALL VILLAGE SANITATION LAWS, SUCH AS SEWAGE
ECT.)

SECTION 3. VIOLATION AND PENALTIES.

ANY PERSON VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE SHALL, ON CON-
VIOLATION THEREOF, BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION
HEREOF BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION
HEREOF SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS.

SECTION 4.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE TWENTY (20)
YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ITS PASSAGE.

AN ORDINANCE TO DEFINE AND REGULATE THE
OPERATION AND USE OF TRAILER COACHES.

The Village of Calumet ordains:

Section 1. Definitions.

For the purpose of this Ordinance, a trailer coach is hereby defined and declared to be any vehicle used or so constructed as to permit its being used as a conveyance upon the public streets and which includes self-propelled and non self-propelled vehicles, so designed, constructed, reconstructed or added to by means of an enclosed addition or room in such a manner as will permit the occupancy thereof as a dwelling or sleeping place for one or more persons, and having as a foundation wheels, jacks or skirtings.

Section 2.

No person, firm or corporation shall use or permit the use of any trailer coach as a residence on any site, lot, field or tract of land within the limits of the Village of Calumet *except in that part of the Village known as Cal Street and Pine Street west of Maple Street* for more than ten (10) days in any one calendar month.

Cal Street and Pine Street west of Maple Street
and upon the lot known as the all village
Section 3. Violation and penalties.

Any person violating this Ordinance shall, on conviction thereof, be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date of its passage.
