## COUNTY OF HOUGHTON

ORDINANCE NO. 121

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND LICENSE PEDDLERS AND HAWKERS DOING BUSINESS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CALUMET.

The Village of Calumet ordains:

Section 1. License required. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to engage in the business of peddler or hawker of any merchandise, article or thing without having first secured a license therefor.

Section 2. Applications. Applications for such licenses shall be made to the Village Clerk during normal business hours at the Village Office at least twenty-four (24) hours before a peddler or hawker commences to engage in business as set forth above. Applications for such licenses shall state the description and number of vehicles, if any, intended to be operated by the peddler or hawker, the kind of merchandise to be peddled, the permanent address of the peddler or hawker, the identity and permanent address of the employer of the peddler or hawker, if the peddler or hawker is employed, and the identity and permanent address of any party or parties who shall receive a share of the gross receipts of the peddler or hawker as the result of the business activities of the peddler or hawker within the Village. In addition, the application shall state the number of days which each peddler or hawker intends to spend while engaged in the business of peddler or hawker within the Village and the proposed dates for the conduct of such business.

Section 3. Fee. The fee for such license shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each peddler or hawker engaged in the business of peddler or hawker in the village plus Three Dollars (\$3.00) per day per peddler or hawker for each day that the peddler or hawker is engaged in such business in the Village.

Section 4. Street Peddlers. No peddler shall ply his vocation on any street, sidewalk, park, or in any other public place unless his peddler's license specifies that peddling in such public places is permitted thereunder. In the event that permission is granted to

a peddler or hawker to ply his vocation in any public place within the Village, the peddler or hawker shall not create any public disburbance or nuisance by so plying his vocation.

Section 5. Fraud. Any peddler or hawker who shall be guilty of any fraud, cheating, or misrepresentation, whether through himself or through an agent or employee, while acting as a peddler or hawker in the Village shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Violation of Ordinance. Failure by any person, firm, or corporation to abide by this Ordinance shall be a violation of this Ordinance. Violations of this Ordinance shall include, but not be limited to the conducting of the business of hawker or peddler without applying for a license or without paying the fee for such license, the falsification of any information contained in an application for a license the omission of any information required to be contained in such application, the barter or sale of any goods, merchandise, or wares other than those specified in the application for a license, and violations of Section 4 and Section 5 of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Penalty. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance will be fined up to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)or may be imprisoned for not more than ninety (90) days or both. A separate offense shall be deemed to be committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 8. Effective date. This Ordinance shall be effective after thirty (30) days from the date of its publication in a news-paper of general circulation in Houghton County, Michigan.
