## VILLAGE OF CALUMET COUNTY OF HOUGHTON ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LOITERING WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CALUMET, DEFINING THE TERM "LOITER", AND PROVIDING A PENALTY IN CASE OF VIOLATION OF THE PROHIBITION.

The Village of Calumet ordains:

Section 1. No person shall loiter on any public street, public alley or public sidewalk or in any public building or public parking lot.

Section 2. For purposes of this ordinance, the term "loiter" shall include any of the following types of conduct:

To be dilatory, to be slow in movement, to stand or sit around or move slowly about, to stand or sit idly around, to spend time idly, to delay, to idle, or to linger, where the effect of such conduct is to:

- (a) block or to obstruct the public place being occupied; or
- (b) create or cause to be created a disturbance or breach of of the peace; or
- (c) obstruct or hinder the passage of pedestrians or vehicles; or
- (d) force pedestrians using any public sidewalk to walk upon a public street and to thereby be exposed to the danger of vehicular traffic.

Section 3. Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of \$25.00 plus court costs for the first offense. For each subsequent offense the penalty shall be a fine of \$40.00 plus court costs or imprisonment in the City jail or County jail for a period not to exceed 90 days or both.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the County of Houghton.
