

ORDINANCE NO. 71...

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO THE CLOSING OF PUBLIC BILLIARD
AND POOL ROOMS, PUBLIC DANCE HALLS AND BALL ALLIES, AND
SOFT DRINK EMPORIUMS.

The Village of Red Jacket Ordains:

Section 1: No public billiard and pool room, public dance hall, ball alley or soft drink emporium shall be kept open between twelve o'clock midnight and seven o'clock in the forenoon of the following day within the corporate limits of the Village of Red Jacket.

Section 2: Every person violating the foregoing section, whether he be owner or the officer, agent or servant of the owner of any of the places therein named, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not to exceed twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, together with costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs shall be imprisoned in the common jail of the county of Houghton for a term not to exceed twenty (20) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be known as ordinance No. 71.
