

ORDINANCE NO. 72.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DRIVERS OF VEHICLES TO FOLLOW FIRE APPARATUS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS, AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY THEREFOR.

The Village of Red Jacket Ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle other than one on official business to follow any fire apparatus travelling in response to a fire alarm closer than five hundred feet, or to drive into or park such vehicle within one block where fire apparatus has stopped in answer to a fire alarm.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not exceeding \$25.00 and costs of prosecution, or if such fine and costs shall not be paid, then by imprisonment in the common jail for the county of Houghton for not exceeding twenty-five days.
