ORDINATOR NO. 75

An Ordinance relative to marking motor vehicles or other vehicles on Mifth Street.

The Village of Calumet ordains:

Sec. 1. No motor vehicle or other vehicle shall be parked on Fifth Street, within the village of Calumet, for a period in excess of one (1) hour, between the hours of 9 A. II. and 6 P. M., on any day of the week except Sunday.

Sec. 2. Any person violating this ordinance shall, upon conviction of said violation, be punished by a fine of not more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs shall be imprisoned in the common jail of the County of Houghton, or the village jail, for a term not exceeding ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be known and numbered as Ordinance No. 75.
