
An ordinance to provide for the appointment of the Village of Calumet village treasurer.

**NOTICE TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF CALUMET**


Take notice that Village Ordinance No. 158, which provides for the appointment of the village treasurer was adopted pursuant to 1895 PA 3, as amended, on Tuesday, July 20, 2021, and will take effect 45 days after the date of adoption unless a petition signed by not less than ten percent of the registered electors of the village is filed with the acting village clerk or village office within the 45-day period, in which case the ordinance will take effect upon the approval of an election held on the question.

Passed and adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Calumet, County of Houghton, and State of Michigan on the 15th day of August, 2023.


