II. Call to Order

a. Pledge of Allegiance

Chair Kobe called the meeting to order at 3:32 PM, and recited the pledge.

IV. Petitions from the Public

One member of the public appeared and spoke. She supports short-term rentals, supports the flexible residential district, thinks the lighting on the public housing near Agassiz Park is too bright, and does not want lights shut off from midnight to 5am.

- c. A motion was made by Commissioner Ranville to accept the Zoning Ordinance with changes and recommend acceptance to the Village Council (VC). Commissioner Green seconded the motion. The motion passed 5/0.
- d. Chair Kobe agreed to write a memo to the VC recommending the VC accept the Zoning Ordinance as written. She will send the memo and updated Zoning Ordinance to Village Manager Amber Goodman to distribute to the VC as soon as possible.

e. Chair Kobe and Commissioner Ranville will attend the VC work session on Tuesday, February 08, 2022, at 6:30pm. Chair Kobe will read the memo to the VC out loud.

VI. Annual Elections

This meeting marked the second annual election since the current commissioners took office. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Green recommended that all officers be re-elected to their current offices. Commissioner Ranville seconded. After more discussion and a vote, the motion passed 5/0.

Chair Kobe mentioned before the meeting closed that her term expires in December, 2022, and she does not plan to serve again.
