I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chair Colleen Kobe at 5:30 PM.

Verbal Roll Call was taken. Present: Commissioners Chris Green, Roxanne King, David Geisler Absent: None Vacant: One Also present: Manager Caleb Katz and 25 members of the public present for varying lengths of time

II. ACCEPTANCE OF AGENDA

Moved by Commissioner Geisler and seconded by Commissioner Geisler to accept the agenda as amended to include Petitions from the Public.

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Chair Kobe, Commissioners Green and Geisler Nays - None

Motion carried unanimously (4/0).

III. AGENDA

1. Petitions from the Public

Members of the public were given five minutes to address the Planing Commission. The majority of comments were favor of allowing a marihuana business in the Village. Comments in favor were mixed with some supporing a medical marihuana business while others supported adult use marihuana businesses and some specifically in support of a business to be operated by Jeff McMahon. Comments were made opposing marihuana businesses in the Village noting the detrimental effects of marihuana use and suggesting the Village follow the 1000 foot buffer zones supported by the School Board.

2. Ordinance 127, Zoning

One member of the public submitted corrections to the draft of Ordinance 127 which were accepted by the Commission.

Commissioner Green noted that a possible expansion by Calumet Machine would necessitate an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance.

Moved by Commissioner Green and seconded by Commissioner King to remove Section 2, Subdivision 3 on non conforming structures from Ordinance 127.

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Commissioner Green Nays - Chair Kobe, Commissioners King and Geisler

Motion failed (1/3).

After discussion as to whether it was necessary to make approval of Ordinance 127 contingent on the Council passing Ordinance 153.

Moved by Commissioner Geisler and seconded by Commissioner King to accept the proposed edits to Ordinance 127 and to approve the ordinance and to send it on to the Council for consideration. The motion also included a provision that the Planning Commission's approval of Ordinance 127 was contingent on the Council voting to approve Ordinance 153, Adult Use Marihuana.

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Chair Kobe, Commissioners Geisler, King and Green Nays - None

Motion carried unanimously (4/0).

3. Adjourn

Moved by Commissioner King and seconded by Commissioner Green to adjourn the meeting at 6:47 PM.
