f. Street Closure Request – 18th Annual Pasty Fest August 20th, 2022

Discussion on the Street closure request for Pasty Fest.

g. Electronic Waste Recycling ADO

Discussion on grant for E-waste <u>collection</u> that may require use of the 4th street parking lot behind family dollar. The application will be done by Mainstreet.

h. Conditional Use Permit Letter for 2015th Street Finalization

Discussion on the letter to be voted on by council for the conditional use permit.

i. Houghton County Recreation Authority Articles of Incorporation

Discussion on the Houghton County Recreation Authority Articles of Incorporation. Council will need to rejoin due to an error in the postings of the articles of incorporation for Houghton County Recreation Authority.

j. Citizen Planner/Zoning Administrator Training Reimbursement

Discussion on zoning training for Manager Goodman. This can be reimbursed by insurance.

k. Sidewalks

Trustee Que spoke about sidewalks and Ordinance 126. Also, discussion on previous request from Monkey Business. Village Council may form a committee meeting on sidewalks.

Member of the public spoke about the sidewalks in front of their residence and asked questions about the responsibility of repairs. Ordinance 126, places the responsibility of repairs on the landowner.

I. Alleys

Trustee Que spoke about recent feedback about alley cleanup, parking in alleys, and Village Maintenance. Discussion on the utilities in the area. It is noted in the winter parking is usually allowable to prevent parking on the street.

Manager Goodman to research the practice of maintenance of alleys in other Villages.
