IV. Unfinished Business

1. Audit / F-65 Report

Susan Sanford (Auditor) presented the Audit and Financial Report for the fiscal year ending February 29, 2024. She apologized for the delay in completing the audit in a timely manner and discussed the issues encountered with last year's compilation and the additional time it took to account for and correct the discrepancies. She noted adjustments to TIF dollars and grant funds (p. 26-27 of the financial report).

Sanford also reviewed her findings and recommendations regarding internal controls and documenting processes and policies.

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2. FY26 Budget Process and Timeline

Haselden discussed the new budget format regarding budget revenues supporting budget expenditures. Discussion of funds in outlying accounts that have not had any activity since 1989. Haselden confirmed that the work session next week will be mainly budget focused. The other agenda item will be the Dangerous Buildings Ordinance.

The Budget Public Hearing will take place at 6:00pm on Tuesday, February 18. The Regular Council Meeting will follow the Public Hearing. A Special Meeting to vote on the FY26 budget and amendments to the FY25 budget will take place at the end of the month in order to ensure the amended budget has all the February expenses accounted for.

V. New Business

1. Employee Contracts

Haselden is working with an ad-hoc committee (Que, Ryan, Weir) to draft a Manager Contract. She is also transitioning all other village positions from contractual to standard employment positions and working on an Employee Handbook. These items will be discussed further during the budget discussions at the next work session.
