A. SHPO HAS A NEW CLG COORDINATOR. WHAT IS ONE THING YOU WOULD LIKE THE NEW COORDINATOR TO UNDERSTAND ABOUT YOUR COMMUNITY AND LOCAL PRESERVATION ACTIVITIES/NEEDS?

The Village of Calumet has faced decades of disinvestment and fiscal challenges but is now in the sixth year of the Bring Back Calumet initiative. This ongoing effort prioritizes the preservation of our historic architecture and the continued significance of our Historic District Commission (HDC) and downtown district, which form the heart of our village. Support from the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) is critical as we work to reshape perceptions of Calumet and revitalize our historic assets. We seek assistance in the form of educational opportunities for HDC staff, increased awareness of Calumet at the state level, and potential grant funding to stabilize and restore our irreplaceable historic resources.

The outreach program that we did in June was successful, we had over 30 people attend and many people expressed appreciation for it - one of our developers submitted for historic tax credits and was approved!

We still have issues with property owners starting work or ordering materials prior to coming for COA approval. The Commission has worked hard to maintain integrity of the district, while still finding compromise with owners in these situations. More outreach is needed for property owners new to the area and with contractors working in the district.

D. WHAT ARE THE MOST CRITICAL PRESERVATION ISSUES/NEEDS FACING YOUR COMMUNITY?

One of the most pressing preservation challenges in our community is the number of endangered historic structures at risk of deterioration or collapse. As the Village Council prepares to enforce the Dangerous Buildings Ordinance this summer, it is crucial to understand how the Historic District Commission (HDC) can play a role in preserving historically significant properties while ensuring public safety. Identifying funding opportunities, technical assistance, and preservation-friendly solutions will be key in balancing enforcement with the long-term protection of Calumet's architectural heritag
